First Sunday of Lent – February 18, 2024

Weekday Masses during Lent

- We currently celebrate the weekday Masses at St. Bernard in the Fr. Granville S.J. Room. For the time of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament during the week, we will be in this room where a time of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed until 3 pm, when those gathered will pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy and close off time of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.
- At St. Rose of Lima, we will continue with the Masses in the main Church for both Wednesday evening and Friday morning. 
