As we reflect on the Scriptures this Sunday, there seems to be an alarming concern in the Book of Numbers (Old Testament) with Joshua and in the Gospel of Mark with the beloved disciple John, over who is speaking in Christ's name. The responses back to mission after "the Lord would put his spirit on them." Jesus' response to John as well was very similar "... for no one who does a deed of power in my name will be able soon afterward to speak evil of me." The whole intent of Christ, the whole purpose of Moses' sojourn leading the people out of the wilderness into the Promised Land, was the proclamation of good deeds of power in God's name - that the joy would fill the soul of the one who is freed from bondage, from sin to rejoice and want that very same

Catechetical Sunday — Throughout the Archdiocese of Halifax-Yarmouth, October 5, 2024 is Catechetical Sunday. Let us pray for all who will share the Faith in and with our families in Faith Formation and our Adult Faith Formation Programs here at St. André thank and pray for all those who have come forward to share the Good News of Jesus Christ and the Teachings of His Church.

Congratulations and Welcome to the Faith — This Sunday at St. Bernard we welcome to the Faith through the Sacrament of Baptism - Kyla, Harrison, Allistair, and Blair. We give thanks to God with Clarissa and Jacob for the care and concern of their family and for bringing them to the Church to grow with our family of faith here at St. André Bessette Parish. We pray God will bestow His most gracious blessings on you all.

First Thursday/First Friday/First Saturday — In the Roman Catholic Tradition, we have in our Church a way of intensifying what we believe in Faith about Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament (Body, Blood Soul & Divinity) present in the Eucharist. We have a long tradition of many and varying devotions. All of these opportunities help us to grow deeper in our Faith and build a stronger relationship with God.

- On the First Thursday of the month, we are able to celebrate a votive Mass in honour of the Eternal High Priest, Jesus Christ/ Holy Eucharist. The Church permits the use of particular prayers which help deepen our understanding of Jesus Christ, High Priest, truly present in the Blessed Sacrament. Mass is at 9 am at St. Bernard, with a time of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until 12:00 pm. Confessions are heard following Mass for 45 minutes.
- On the First Friday of the month, we are able to celebrate a Mass in honour of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We remember from the side of Christ came water and blood – signs of Baptism and Eucharist, the Sacrifice Christ made for you and me that we would draw close to His Most Sacred Heart and be protected and guided, that our Hearts could be formed and one with His. Mass is at 9 am at St. Rose of Lima, with a time of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until 12 pm. Confessions are heard following Mass for 45 minutes. We also offer a time of prayer at St. Bernard, a Holy Hour from 7 to 8 pm (Confessions throughout the time of Adoration and Benediction at 8 pm).
- On the *First Saturday of the month*, we are able to celebrate a votive Mass for the Blessed Virgin Mary. This enables us to grow in a greater awareness of Mary, the Mother of God, entrusted by Jesus to his Beloved Disciple at the foot of the Cross and because of that, to us. We honour Mary for Christ her Son, we do not worship Mary. Mary will always guide us back to her Son Jesus – "Do whatever he tells vou..." Through Mary to Jesus, Mass is at 9 am, followed by Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 9:45 to 10:45 am, with confessions heard during this time.

Masses are offered on these days in our Parish and it would be great to see more people taking advantage of what is being offered for your benefit in Faith and for the glory and honour of God.

Eucharistic Ministers Needed — Have you ever considered how **beloved** you are by Our Lord Jesus Christ? Have you ever considered becoming a **Eucharistic Minister** in response to His Awesome Love for you? Eucharistic Ministers only serve one Sunday per month, in a rotation with other friends and parishioners who have answered Our Lord's call to feed His people. Instruction is provided in one session (about a half an hour) outside of Sunday Mass. Perhaps the first response to this call is: I am not worthy! The answer to this thought is: No one is worthy! But He calls us
