Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

A vocation is a call from God and each one of us has a vocation. Knowing one's vocation enables each of us to live out the mission of the Church. So what exactly is a vocation?

A vocation involves using our unique gifts to serve God and His Church. When vocations are lived out, they witness God's goodness active in the Church. Discerning these roles in an ongoing process facilitated by the programming offered through the Archdiocese. This provides clergy and lay persons with the formation, training, and skills necessary to carry out their service to God.

A number of programs the Archdiocese offers to help support faith formation and vocations include:

- The EQUIP program fosters adult faith formation through classes offered at the Atlantic School
  of Theology spanning three years, which provides participants with the tools to become leaders
  in their community and parish. Currently, there are 26 students enrolled.
- The Archdiocese is financially supporting priestly formation with four seminarians attending seminary as well as diaconate formation with eight candidates.
- The Archdiocesan staff provides on-going support and coaching for pastoral teams and lay
  persons with the goal of providing the skills and tools to support pastoral ministry.

These initiatives are made possible by the continued generosity of parishioners. Giving is a way we can honour God for all that has been provided to us, which in turn plays an integral part in carrying out the Church's mission.
