Sixth Sunday of Ordinary Time - February 11, 2024

There many stories in the Gospels of Jesus' healing ministry, and his Mission of proclamation of the Gospel and call to conversion. This Sunday, it's the healing of the marginalized man with leprosy. Jesus lets nothing hold back a person who desires in faith for something which is good. The words "If you choose, you can make me clean." are words containing Faith, filled with Hope, lived and expressed in Love. Jesus always wills the good for others – there is no magic, only mystery of Faith. The closer we come to Jesus, the more we have the opportunity to get to know Him and the more He chooses to heal and give life. Our lives need to be lived with the kind of Faith this man with leprosy had – know what Jesus can actually do and believe we can receive it, if only we would ask with a heart and mind of Faith.

The Way of the Cross — This Friday, February 16, we will gather at St. Rose of Lima at 7 pm for the Praying of the Way of the Cross. Some of our young people will be leading us. I invite you all to come and pray with our young people as we reflect on the Way of Jesus' journey with the Cross. Thank you to all who will lead us in this walk with Jesus, for our Salvation.

Here I Am Lord. Send Me!

The St. Rose of Lima CWL, St. Bernard CWL and Holy Cross Ladies Association invite parishioners of St. André Bessette to support two important initiatives, which the ladies are hoping will help to protect two vulnerable segments of Canadian Society as well as align with our Catholic values.

The first initiative is a petition to support Bill S-210: Protecting Young Persons from Exposure to Pornography Act. This Act is supported by the CCCB (Canadian Council of Catholic Bishops). The CCCB stated: "The Catholic Women's League of Canada would be better positioned to protect young persons from exposure to pornography, including possibly to support Bill S-210."

The second initiative is a postcard campaign to advise the Government of Canada of Canadians' concern that the waiver for accessing MAiD (Medical Assistance in Dying) for people suffering with mental illness will be lifted on March 17, 2024. While a January 29 CBC news brief reported the government may delay lifting the waiver beyond March 17, the intent remains steadfast to include those with mental illness under the MAiD governance.

This Sunday, the ladies of St. André Bessette Parish will have available:

- 1. the petition for those parishioners who wish to support the protection of children from pornographic internet content, and
- 2. the postcard to discourage the government from lifting the waiver for mentally-ill persons to access MaiD.

Please consider the significance of these important actions and support the essence of the CWL's motto of *Catholic and Living It*.

Weekday Masses during Lent — Often we will see a growth in the number of attendees at weekday Masses during Lent.

- If we come to a point where the Fr. Granville S.J. Room at St. Bernard is not able to accommodate on Tuesday evening and Thursday morning, we will move Mass to the Church during the week. For the time of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament during the week at St. Bernard, we will transfer the Eucharist on Thursday morning after Mass to the Fr. Granville S.J. Room where a time of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed until 3 pm, when those gathered will pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy and close off time of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.
- At St. Rose of Lima, we will continue with the Masses in the main Church for both Wednesday evening and Friday morning. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on Friday will remain in the main Church throughout Lent. We will extend the time for Adoration until 3 pm Friday afternoon, when those who are gathered will pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy and close off time of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.
- At Holy Cross, Deacon Dan and Fr. Gerald will be alternating weeks offering Mass (Fr. Gerald)/Liturgy of the Word (Deacon Dan) at 12 noon on Tuesdays during Lent, followed by a Lenten Program using Lectio: Unveiling Scripture & Tradition on the Eucharist. This will begin on Tuesday, February 20 at 12 noon with Mass - Session 1 of the video series - Source & Summit: Introducing the Eucharist.

Prayer and Spirituality: Lent 2024 — We will be offering the **Way of the Cross each Friday during Lent**, alternating between St. Bernard and St. Rose of Lima. This will be an opportunity to have all three churches come together to pray and reflect on the journey of Jesus' Way of the Cross. The Forgiveness Video Program will be offered this year at St. Rose of Lima on Wednesday evenings following the 6:30 pm Mass. Stay tuned for further updates.

Formed.org — Just a reminder to all parishioners that we have this site for Faith Formation, family conversation starters, small group discussion, family movie night, and so much more. This gift which is easy to use in the comfort of our own homes. Please take advantage ot it!
