
Month of November — We are drawn to remember all souls of the Faithful Departed - family, friends, parishioners, those we may not even know but who strived to build a community of Faith right here where we are. November can be a heavy month, especially for those whose loss is very recent. Going through grief and the loss of a loved one is never easy. There are many people who have impacted our lives, who have helped us grow in our Faith, who have maybe even introduced us to a relationship Christ. There may be people who we were at odds with, unable to forgive. There may be people we want to apologize to for having hurt them. There may be numerous other realities. The month of November can indeed be a very heavy -laden month acknowledging loss. However, in tune with what Christ calls us to, it can be a month that can bear much fruit when we pray for the dead. Our hope is in Christ and in Him Risen from the Dead. Our hope for our brothers and sisters in Christ who have died is that they would be with God – our family member, our friends and yes even those we might consider our enemies. Eternal Rest, grant unto them, O Lord. And let perpetual light shine upon them. May the souls of all the Faithful Departed, through the mercy of God, Rest in Peace!!

St. André Bessette Remembrance of Faithful Departed in the Past Year — In the third week of November, we will have an opportunity to gather with those who have lost loved ones in the past year. We will have a special Mass for those who died and were buried from St. André Bessette Parish and we also place an invitation to parishioners who have lost immediate family members from outside our parish. Our first Mass will be at St. Bernard on Tuesday, November 14 at 6:30 pm. Our second Mass will be at St. Rose of Lima on Wednesday, November 15 at 6:30 pm. We invite family members of those who have died in our parish to attend Mass at the church they were buried from. Those who have lost immediate family members in the past year, whose funeral and burial took place elsewhere, are invited to come to either celebration. So that we can be organized and ready light candles, I ask any in the above category to call the parish office and indicate which Mass you will be attending and ensure we have the name of those not buried from here. Let us remember to pray for the dead, that they may share in eternal life with God, and for the families who are mourning the loss of loved ones, that they may truly be consoled.

Remembrance Day, November 11 — Our prayers for the dead (Faithful Departed) continue through the month of November. In the coming week, we honor those who have fought bravely in the various World Wars. November 11 is truly a day we dedicate to remember and honor those who have lost their lives in the fight for freedom and peace. On this day, we also remember those who are presently engaged in peace-keeping forces, those who are engaged in the war in Israel and the Gaza Strip, Ukraine and Russia. It is a day we can gather at the Cenotaph and enter into the ceremonies. It is also a day we can set some time aside with our families and our communities to pray and remember. The words Lest We Forget contain and emphasize a particular need to remember. Our Faith teaches us ... to remember all that Jesus Christ did and said for our sake, that we might live our lives so as to be models of living the Christian life in the midst of the broken world in need of mending and healing. 
