

28TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME — OCTOBER 15, 2023

This Sunday, we are given an opportunity to think about how we respond to God's invitation to the Kingdom Feast. In the midst of living our lives in this busy world, we may find ourselves not always able to keep up with the pace. We may just decide to pull back from everything except the things we enjoy.
