Forgiveness Reflection

- This Tuesday, March 14 following the 6:30 pm Mass, we will gather in the Hall at St. Bernard Church at approximately 7:15 pm and reflect with Part V: Body, Soul & Spirit and Part VI: Feeling - Excuse for not Forgiving.
- This **Thursday**, March 16 at 3:00 pm we will gather at Holy Cross Church for the last of our four-week reflection on Forgiveness. This gathering we will cover Part VII: Decide to Forgive and Part VIII: Perfect Forgiveness. Following reflection and discussion, we will pray together the Way of the Cross, after which we will enjoy a meal. On March 23, we will pray The Way of the Cross at 3:00 pm followed by Mass.

On March 30, we will pray The Way of the Cross, followed by a time for individual confession.

Archbishop Brian Dunn's Pastoral Visit – Last weekend we had the opportunity to greet Archbishop Dunn at all the four Masses in our Parish. On Saturday morning, the Pastoral Council, Finance Council, Parish Leadership Team, and Faith Formation as well as the Executives of the Catholic Women's League Executive and Knights of Columbus met with Archbishop Dunn to express where we are, share some of our questions and concerns, and hear Archbishop Dunn's vision and direction for the Archdiocese. In the afternoon, our newly-combined Ways & Means Committee met to share some ways to move forward and once again to hear some encouraging words from our Archbishop. Archbishop Dunn encouraged us to assist him on our Parish level to strive for the unity that our Church needs. It was a very good and busy weekend. I would like to thank all who participated in the meetings and organized the weekend. We await Archbishop Dunn's report of his weekend with us.

Chrism Mass — We are invited to join Archbishop Dunn and the Priests of the Archdiocese at the celebration of the Chrism Mass at Saint Mary's Cathedral Basilica on Tuesday, April 4 at 12 noon. At this Mass, the Priests will renew their Priestly Commitment and the Archbishop will bless the Oil of Catechumens and Oil of the Sick and consecrate the Sacred Chrism. These are oils used in all of our Parishes for Baptism, Confirmation, Anointing of the Sick, and Ordination throughout the year. These oils will be processed to the altar at the beginning of our Holy Thursday celebration. Please mark you calendars and plan to attend. Note: Archbishop Dunn has invited all staff to join in this celebration so the Parish Offices will be closed that day.
