Messages from Father Gerald

Financial Report for St. André Bessette Parish — Our Financial Report is prepared and will be presented to the Parish this weekend. This report contains some of the complexities of the reality of two former parishes amalgamated along with our mission. It is reflective of the way in which our Church has been affected by Covid. I want to thank you for your patience, but most importantly I want to thank you for your generous support to keep our mission as a Church working in this portion of the Vineyard of the Lord that we call St. André Bessette Parish. If you have any questions, please feel free to email them to the Parish Offices and they will be forwarded on to those on our Finance Council.

Chrism Mass — We are invited to join Archbishop Dunn and the Priests of the Archdiocese at the celebration of the Chrism Mass at Saint Mary's Cathedral Basilica on Tuesday, April 4 at 12 noon. At this Mass, the Priests will renew their Priestly Commitment and the Archbishop will bless the Oil of Catechumens and Oil of the Sick and consecrate the Sacred Chrism. These are oils used in all of our Parishes for Baptism. Confirmation. Anointing of the Sick, and Ordination throughout the year. These oils will be processed to the altar at the beginning of our Holy Thursday celebration. Please mark you calendars and plan to attend. The liturgy will also be broadcast by live stream and available on the diocesan website and Facebook. Note: Archbishop Dunn has invited all staff to join in this celebration so the parish offices will be closed that day.

Holy Week Celebrations at St. André Bessette Parish — This will be our first fully-open Holy Week since the naming of the new Parish of St. André Bessette. I pray that we will gather for all the liturgies that make up the Holy Week experience – that we may be able to experience the sense of family we have been called to be. The Triduum (three Holy Days) contains the necessary continuity to draw us through the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus. Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil are one liturgy – the Last Supper – institution of the Eucharist and Jesus' call to service, the crucifixion (the Cross) is central on Good Friday, and the new light, new water and new life at the Easter Vigil. The beauty of the journey of these three days and then on Easter Sunday – being blessed to be able to renew our own Baptismal Promises, receiving the new water leading us to celebrate the joy of the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. I realize that many travel on Easter weekend to be with family, however, I really encourage and urge all of you to participate fully in celebrating. So, if you are here, make it a point to come to Church. Times and locations are listed on the front page. May we pray for a deeper acceptance and understanding of God's Mercy and Love as we journey through Holy Week into the joy of being an Easter people!!!

Divine Mercy Novena and Divine Mercy Sunday Holy Hour — Beginning on Good Friday, we are encouraged to pray a nine-day Novena of Divine Mercy. Each day there is a specific prayer intention accompanied by the prayers and praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet. This will bring us to focus on the many and varied needs to be brought before the throne of God's Mercy. On April 16, the Second Sunday of Easter, designated now as the Divine Mercy Sunday, we will gather and offer a Holy Hour at 3:00 pm at St. Rose of Lima Church – to bless and revere the image of Mercy, pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Litany of Mercy and receive Benediction.
