Other small groups meet to learn and pray.</li><li>- Group formed to create a pathway to Evangelization in Parish; identify new leaders; promote missionary disciples.</li><li>- Family Catechetics program now established.</li><li>- Livestream Masses invite people to attend in person.</li><li>- Regular Sunday Mass attendance increased by about 20%.</li><li>- We share one bulletin; one office &amp; all programs/events open to all. Increase in cross-community participation.</li><li>- Parish picnic held at Holy Cross and well/enthusiastically attended by large group; overfilled Church. HC accepted as unique part of Parish even if small &amp; distant.</li></ul>

Overlap of 'help' happens as groups/communities work in silos. Inter community/programs communication is critical.</li> <li>- We need a Communications team to plan and promote the good things happening in Parish.</li> <li>- We need to teach parish what Social Justice can be other than financial aid as attitude, inclusion and small deeds.</li> <li>- A need for a platform and vehicle to share successes and ID needs; to encourage a broader participation.</li> <li>- Need to work with Finance Council to establish budget amount and parameters for aid.</li> <li>- Faith communities need to know all the good deeds being carried out. As we enter our third year, the focus continues to be on building relationships with parents, teachers, and parishioners to educate and build awareness and interest in the program. Presently the program is short of Catechists. Too often because of the shortage, parents need to step up to teach. This year, St. Bernard has 5 parents, 2 of which are teaching and so they miss out on the parental sessions. The challenge will be to recruit more catechists from our parishioners.</li> <li>- Communication is the key to problem solving. Involving the parish and communicating to them that we need help to keep our program running is imperative. Maria, our Faith Coordinator plans to address the parish on this matter.</li> </ul>

children and families in their faith journey		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Enrollment is down at both churches this year. There are 10 students enrolled at St Bernard; some families withdrew, and some new families registered. St Rose of Lima has 20 students: down 15 students from the previous year. Several families did not register for the program this year due to extracurricular and other time restraints. Several families moved to another parish. It was a struggle to have children and parents attend classes and sessions. This precipitated Maria to “take a more laid-back approach”, sometimes having to plan sessions around their schedules.</li> <li>- Adult Faith Formation: Last year we had about 50 participants gather for “Metanoia” which was held over several weeks. In preparation for the Eucharistic Congress, our Parish hosted 2 workshops: The Mystery of the Eucharist” and” Let’s talk about Jesus in the Eucharist”. Both gatherings were well attended and spiritually prepared parishioners for the Eucharistic Congress with 38 St. André Bessette parishioners attend.</li> <li>- Father Mark Cherry continues to educate us on a monthly basis and there are plans for him to host a Lenten mission at the parish. We expect to see future faith development opportunities in 2025 which will help prepare parishioners to become future and confident leaders. Small personal bible study groups often emerge after the larger gathering; a wonderful way to evangelize and share our faith. Recruitment in church ministries can greatly increase when we see people come forward after these gatherings, energized and strong in their faith and excited to participate.</li> </ul>
