23RD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME **SEPTEMBER 10, 2023**

The Gospel for this Sunday is known as Jesus' "community discourse" — how the community of the faithful should treat one another. Paul's letter to the Romans also concerns itself with how people treat one another, with his reference to the Old Testament and the commandments that focus on being in right relationship with each other. This indeed does take a lot of work and effort. It involves forgiveness and it involves more than second chances. Most importantly, it involves a grace and a strength that does not come from us entirely. It begins with recognizing what God gives to you and me. The tools of forgiveness are recognizing God's generous and wasteful offer of mercy time and again, even to me and you who are undeserving of such a gift. I guess the big question is "What makes you/me so much more important than God that you/I could forgo forgiving anyone else?" Concern for the other in our earthly journey has to trump everything else we believe is important. For many us, it takes a lifetime to learn this lesson. ... Fr. Gerald
