Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time - January 28, 2024

This Sunday, we are given a great opportunity to recognize how God's Word comes to us. In the First Reading from the Book of Deuteronomy, Moses and the Prophets act as intermediary between God and God's people. They are to guide God's people on earth and they cannot add anything to or take away anything from what God says - the message is to remain unaltered. The importance here is that God's message gets to the People of God. Paul speaks of the various states in life and how "Regardless of our state in life, our primary vocation granted through our Baptism calls us to devote ourselves to prayer and serving God. Paul reminds us that all other concerns will fall into place when we do so." (Quote taken from Workbook for Lectors, Gospel Readers, and Proclaimers of the Word). The Gospel from Mark speaks of Jesus' miraculous healings and his fame, which was beginning to spread further and further. Today, as we seek God's help through Jesus His Son, let's be aware that through the Eucharist (most excellently), through a deeper reflection of Sacred Scripture, and through the ways in which God uses people as he places them in our lives, we will receive what is necessary – God's Grace is enough.

Adult Faith Formation — As we continue to live out our Baptismal Commitment in this new year of grace, there are many opportunities available to us to renew and strengthen our Faith. In order to assist our Family of Faith here at St. André Bessette Parish, we have been granted a year to use Formed.org from the Augustine Institute. Formed.org has many opportunities for all ages to grow in our Faith - movies for families, shows for kids, adult faith formation series, etc... Parishioners should have received this week, by email, instructions on how to sign up so to take advantage of all the site has to offer.

The Way of the Cross — It is our normal practice throughout the Season of Lent to pray the Stations of the Cross as a community. So, we invite you to join us in prayer at either St. Rose of Lima or St. Bernard on Friday evenings at 7 pm during Lent. We will alternate Churches, beginning with St. Rose of Lima on February 16 and the following week at St. Bernard (note the detailed poster on the bulletin boards). Thank you to all who will lead us in this walk with Jesus for our Salvation.

Praying of the Rosary — Each Tuesday night prior to the 6:30 pm Mass at St. Bernard in Enfield, members of the Knights of Columbus will lead the praying of the Rosary. Please join at 6 pm.

Prayer and Spirituality: Lent 2024 — In the next few weeks, we will be putting together some Faith/Spiritual programs for our Lenten Season to accommodate your spiritual journey. We will be offering the Way of the Cross each Friday during Lent, alternating between St. Bernard and St. Rose of Lima. This will be an opportunity to have all three Churches come together to pray and reflect on the journey of Jesus' Way of the Cross. The Forgiveness Video Program will be offered this year at St. Rose of Lima on Wednesday evenings following the 6:30 pm Mass. Stay tuned for further updates.

Small Groups (Lent) — During Lent, we would like to invite parishioners throughout St. André Bessette Parish to gather in home groups for a time of prayer - scripture study, faith formation, Lectio Divina (praying with the Gospel of the Sundays of Lent). We presently have Formed.org, which can provide many different ways to enrich your Lenten journey and growth in Faith. We are hoping that this can be organized by individuals and include people from your neighborhood or friends from the parish, or people you may not really know well but are familiar with from our parish, and that this time of prayer will assist the community to grow. If you are interested in forming a small group during Lent, could you please let us know by contacting Lynette at the Parish Office. Hopefully, sometime after Lent, you will be able to share with Father or any member of the Parish Leadership Team (Phil Francis, Shannon McDonald, Sarah White, and Deacon Dan) how things went with your small group. Sometimes (most times) stepping out of our comfort zone, which is not always easy, can result in some wonderful, good and healthy relationships to grow and give Glory to God.

St. Bernard Church Weekday Masses — Masses during the week at St. Bernard are now being held in the Fr. Granville S.J. Room, which is in the basement of the Residence. We are using this room because of the cost of heating the church throughout the week (hopefully we will save a bit on oil). You may gain entry through the side door in the tunnel connecting the Church and Residence OR if you wish to avoid the use of stairs, the back door nearest the garage will be unlocked for entry. Someone please double check that both doors are locked after Mass or after Adoration on Thursday.

Greeters/Hospitality at St. Rose of Lima — As we don't currently have a coordinator for greeters, a sign-up sheet has been placed at the entrance of the church. Greeters are asked to consider their availability for the next few months and to place their names on the list. We are asking for two greeters per Mass. If you interested in becoming a member of the hospitality team (and would possibly enjoy the coordinator roll), contact Lynette at the parish office. Responsibilities include counting and recording the number of people in attendance, asking a family to bring up the offerings after the collection, getting any gluten-free hosts requested, and handing out bulletins at the end of Mass. This is a beautiful ministry that puts smiles on the faces of those who enter the church.
