HAPPY EASTER - The Lord is Risen! Truly He is Risen!! Alleluia Alleluia

Today we continue to hear of the many appearances of Jesus to his disciples, post resurrection. The disciples experience mixed emotions: terror, fright, doubt and disbelief, but also joy and amazement. Jesus continues to help them open their minds to understand the Scriptures – Those are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you – that everything written about me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets, and the Psalms must be fulfilled.
